HOW TO: Puppy/Kitten Proof Your House

- Ⓢ Hide all cords or unplug them. (electrical, blind pulls, etc.)
- Ⓢ Keep cabinets latched shut and cover or hide the garbage.
- Ⓢ Remove items off tables/counters that are potentially within reach.
- Ⓢ For kittens-provide many options for scratching (posts, corrugated cardboard scratchers, etc.)
- Ⓢ For puppies- provide many options for chewing (crushed rawhide treats-give when you are present and watching- nylabones, toys stuffed with treats)
- Ⓢ Keep cleaners, houseplants, swallowable items (including string) and other potentially toxic materials in a cabinet up high.
- Ⓢ Use Bitter Apple Spray on areas that could potentially be chewed. (Test on fabric first)
